**Speaker:** Dr. Jake Mulder of the Fuller Youth Institute

Jake Mulder, PhD, is the assistant chief of leadership formation at Fuller Seminary, executive director for the non-degreed online Christian leader training platform FULLER Equip, and senior adviser for the Fuller Youth Institute and TENx10 Collaboration.

The focus of Jake's presentation will be the research and results of their new book, *Future Focused Church*, a collaboration of Jake Mulder, Kara Powell, and Raymond Chang.

A synopsis of *Future Focused Church*:
